

## **Privacy Policy**

**Updated: October 2008**

We want you to protect your Personal Data. We define Personal Data as any data from which it is practical to directly determine your identity or the identity of any individual. We have established this Privacy Policy to explain how Personal Data is collected on Piratehomecoming.com, and how this Personal Data is used by Piratehomecoming.com. Any capitalized term not defined in this Privacy Policy has the meaning Piratehomecoming.com which we lay out in the Piratehomecoming.com Terms of Service Document. From time to time, we will update this Privacy Policy.

We take protecting your Personal Data very seriously. All Networks on Piratehomecoming.com are required to meet the terms of our Privacy Policy. That being said, we would like to ask you to be careful and use caution when providing Personal Data to Piratehomecoming.com.

By providing Personal Information on Piratehomecoming.com, you agree (1) to comply with the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy, and (2) that Piratehomecoming.com may process (i.e., collect, use, etc.) your Personal Data as described in this Privacy Policy or the Terms of Service. Personal Data may be processed by Piratehomecoming.com or User(s) in the country where it was collected as well as other countries (including the United States) where laws regarding processing of Personal Data may be less stringent.

### **Piratehomecoming.com and Collection of User Information**

#### **Personally Identifiable User Information**

Once you register with Piratehomecoming.com and sign in to Piratehomecoming.com, you are not anonymous to Piratehomecoming.com.

When registering on Piratehomecoming.com, you provide Personal Data, which includes a full name, an email and the events you may be interested in attending.

You can decline to share such Personal Data with us by not registering on Piratehomecoming.com. Further, you may opt to remove any Personal Data from our active database by contacting Piratehomecoming.com and requesting that we delete your information.

Piratehomecoming.com does not intentionally gather Personal Data about visitors who are under the age of 13.

### **Cookies and Passive Data Collection**

Piratehomecoming.com automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, Piratehomecoming.com cookie information, and the pages you request.

Users should be aware that other websites visited before entering Piratehomecoming.com might place personally identifiable information within a User's URL during a visit to their website, and Piratehomecoming.com has no control over such websites. Accordingly, some of this information may be logged by a subsequent website that collects URL information.

### **How Piratehomecoming.com Uses Information Personally Identifiable Information**

We will send you email updates regarding homecoming events at Hampton University or news about Piratehomecoming.com. We may also send you notice of new Content that has been added to the site in which you may be interested. In some cases, we may also send you primarily promotional messages. In your account, you can choose to opt out of promotional messages and new Content notices.

### **Cookies and Passive Data Collection**

Piratehomecoming.com uses cookies to save session validators, and on Users' browsers and hard drives, and may use them to provide tailored products and services to those Users, as they become available.

IP Addresses also help us to diagnose problems with our server, to administer Piratehomecoming.com, and to otherwise provide the Piratehomecoming.com service to its users. IP addresses may be disclosed to a third party if we believe in good faith that the law or legal process requires it, or to protect the rights or property of Piratehomecoming.com, its Users or the general public.

### **Disclosures**

#### **Piratehomecoming.com Service Providers**

Piratehomecoming.com may need to provide your Personal Data to third parties to deliver specific messages to you (such as an email blasting vendor). These third parties are required not to disclose your Personal Data and not to use your Personal Data other than to provide the services requested by Piratehomecoming.com.

**Law Enforcement**

Piratehomecoming.com may disclose Personal Data if required by a subpoena or other judicial or administrative order, where required by law, or, at our sole discretion, where we deem necessary to protect the safety of any individual or the general public or to prevent violation of our Terms of Service or the rights of Piratehomecoming.com or any third party.

**Change of Ownership**

In the event of a change in ownership, or a merger with, acquisition by, or sale of assets to, another entity, we reserve the right to transfer all of Piratehomecoming.com's User information, including email addresses, to that new entity. Piratehomecoming.com will notify Users (via a posting on this site or email at Piratehomecoming.com's discretion of such a transfer, and Users may choose to modify their registration information at that time. This means if you are concerned about your Personal Data migrating to a new owner, you can request that the site delete your personal information via email.

**Security**

Piratehomecoming.com uses industry standard security measures to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control. Although we make good faith efforts to store the information collected by Piratehomecoming.com in a secure operating environment that is not available to the public, Piratehomecoming.com cannot guarantee complete security. Further, while we work hard to ensure the integrity and security of our network and systems, we cannot guarantee that our security measures will prevent third-party "hackers" from illegally obtaining this information.

**No Spam Policy**

Our No Spam Policy and Terms of Service prohibit all Users from engaging in any activity involving the sending of email in violation of applicable law. Violations of these policies may result in immediate termination of service and legal action against any spammers.

Any unauthorized use of Piratehomecoming.com computer systems is a violation of the Terms of Service and certain federal and state laws, including without limitation the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (18 U.S.C. section 1030 et seq.), Section 502 of the California Penal Code and Section 17538.45 of the California Business and Professions Code.
